

SYSTEMS ADMINISTRATOR

The Systems Administrator is responsible for general IT support for the Lucky Friday Mine. Scope includes networks, process computers, end-user computers, switches, access points, fiber-optic/Ethernet/ISP, and connectivity with SCADA, instrumentation, and controls.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following.

- Design and configure SA-related solutions for various project and operational needs.
- Configure connectivity with SCADA, instrumentation, and controls around continuously-evolving remote monitoring and control systems.
- Contribute to and maintain system standards, protocols, policies, and systems performance metrics, and training.
- Research and recommend innovative and automated approaches for system administration tasks.
- Assist and enable users to fully utilize IT system as needed to support Lucky Friday's business at all levels.
- Install, configure, and maintain desktops, laptops, printers, and mobile devices.
- Assist with the design, development, and implementation of information systems and business solutions for the Lucky Friday.
- Conduct reviews to assess quality assurance practices.
- Provide support, advise, assist, and resolve problems for all users as needed.
- Troubleshoot and resolve hardware and network connectivity issues.
